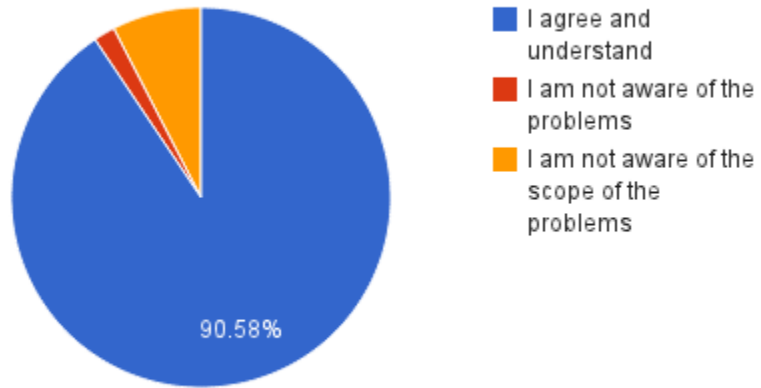


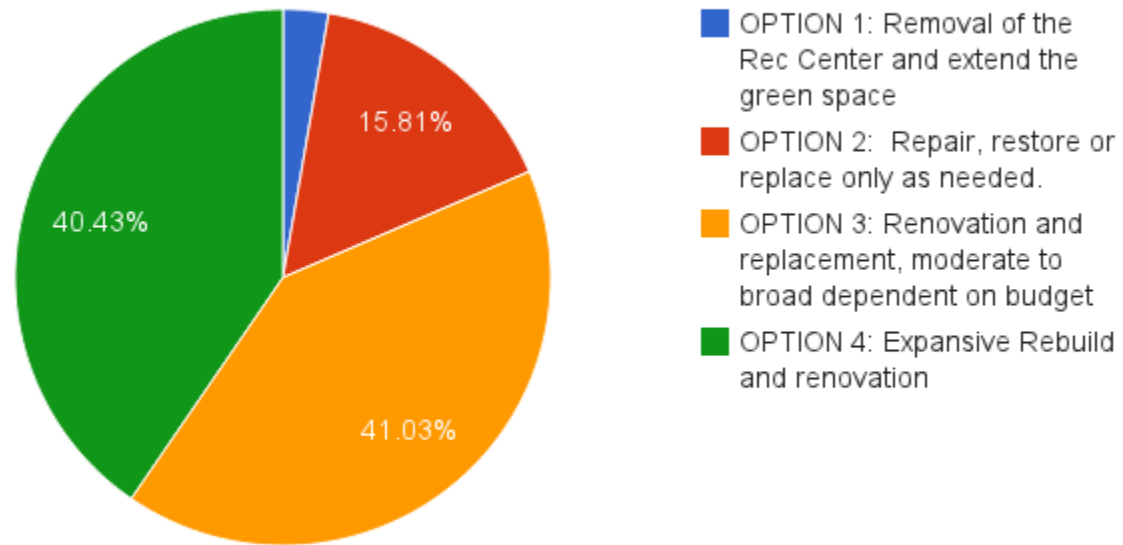
Question 1: I realize that there are structural failings that need to be addressed at the Administration Building and Pool.

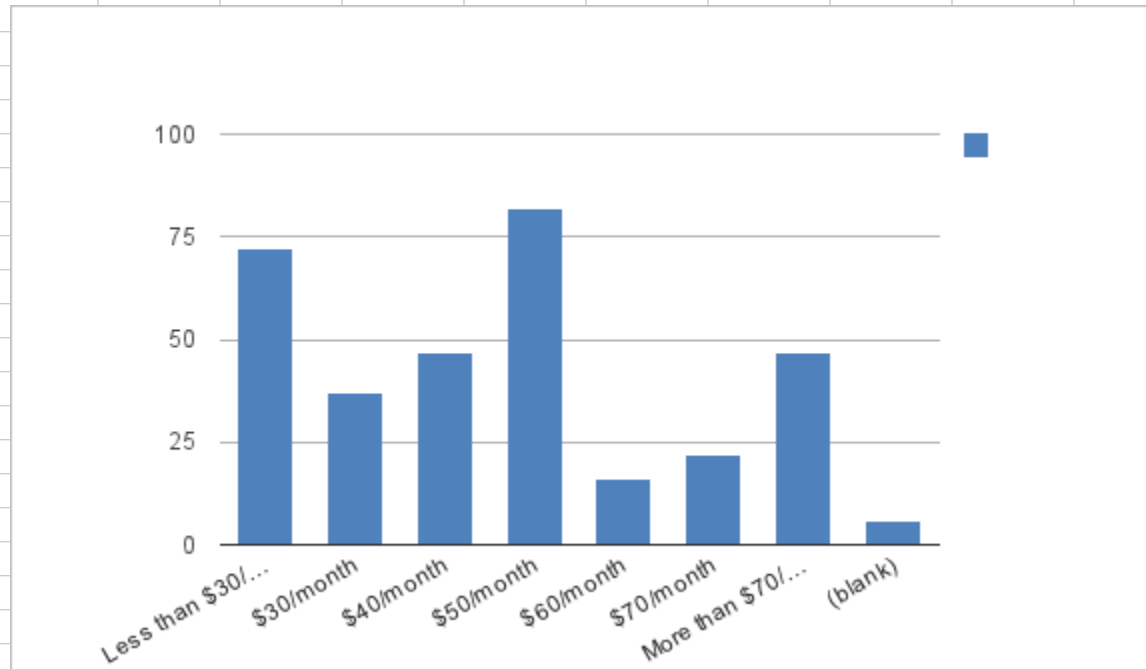

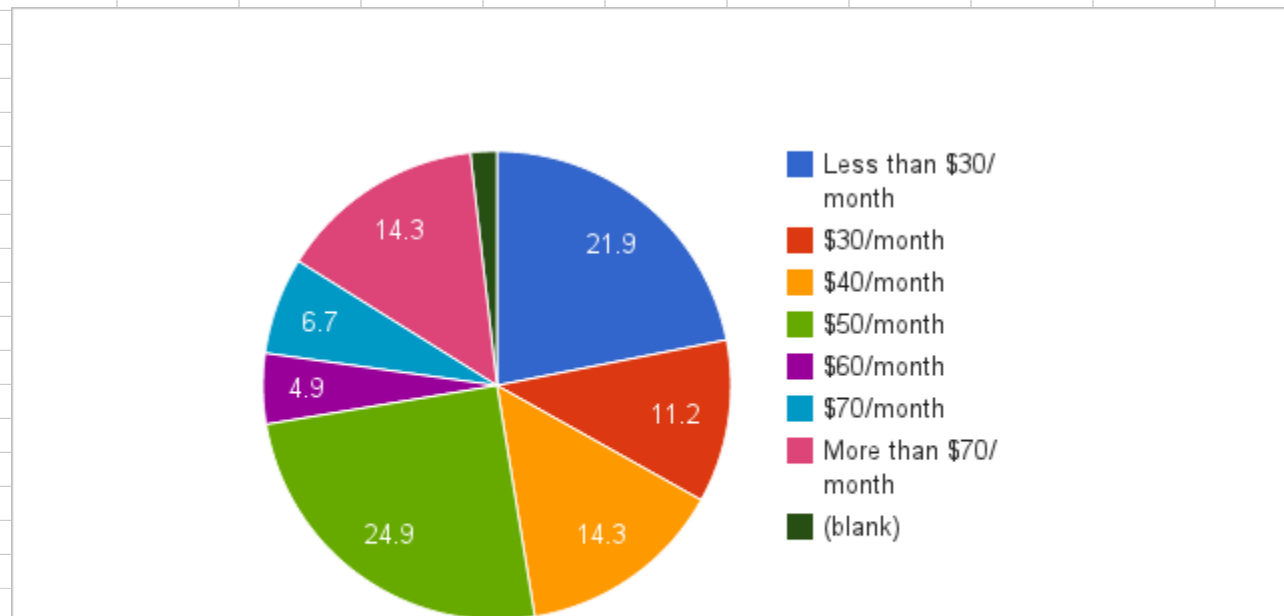

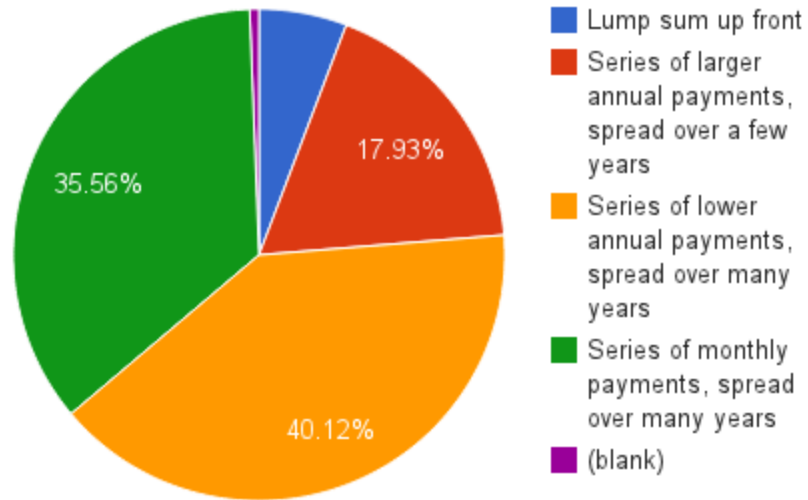
